1. The main topic was “ How to prepare Resume” and “ Career Opportunities in Computerized Accounting”. A total no. of 85 students were present.
2. A one day workshop on the topics “ Entrepreneurial Development ” was organized by Career Counseling and Placement Cell in collaboration with Commerce Department on 12 October, 2023. The main speaker on this occasion were Mr. Rajesh, Mr. Ishwar Singh and Mr. Narendra Singh from Hits Bullseye. The main topic was Entrepreneurship. A total no. of 80 students were present.
